### **Institute Check-in:**

The event begins on Monday, July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023, with registration taking place from 2:30 to 4:00 PM (**Eastern Time Zone**). Check in for Institute will be simultaneous with lodging check-in. The first check-in point will be to drop off your suitcase and receive your room key at Irvington House. After stopping at housing, you can walk to Ford Salon, Robertson Hall where institute check-in will be located. Institute begins at 4:00 p.m. so it is encouraged to arrive at least 30 minutes before to have time to check in at Irvington and walk to Robertson Hall.

Please park in the visitors parking garage located at 4682-4698 Sunset Avenue. The parking garage is about an 8-10 minute walk from Irvington House. You are welcome to drop off your bags at Irvington before heading to the parking garage. Once checked-in to your room, volunteers will guide you over to the Robertson Hall where the sessions will take place on Monday at 4:00 PM. Parking will have you take a ticket, you will receive a card upon housing check in to use upon exiting to avoid payment.

### Lodging/Room Check-in:

Monday evening lodging will be in Irvington House. Each suite consists of 2 double rooms connected by one bathroom. The facility is air conditioned, and comes with bed, dresser and

desk. You will need to bring - Bed linens (twin XL), blankets, pillow, bath towel, wash cloth, and all cosmetics (soap, shampoo, conditioner, and toilet paper) THESE ARE NOT PROVIDED.

## What else to bring:

Bring your **college/university name tag** to wear during the institute! Bring business cards to share with your new colleagues. And you might want to bring a writing instrument and something to write on. Water bottles are not provided so it is encouraged to bring a personal water bottle to use at refill stations. Alcohol for the Monday evening social is not provided and prohibited in halls.

#### Dress:

"Casual Friday" dress is fine throughout the event. We encourage jeans or shorts, comfortable clothing and sporting your Institutional apparel is always encouraged! Some activities will require movement up and down stairs.

#### Meals:

Your fee includes the following: Monday dinner as well as breakfast and lunch on Tuesday. Coffee will not be provided on Tuesday morning, but there is a Starbucks not far from campus that is available. Directions can be found <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a>.
